Welcome to North Cove

Regulations

1. Use of vacant moorings is free to transient boaters. A yellow ribbon indicates a mooring is expected to be vacant for an extended period.
2. Transients may use the town dock as a means of coming ashore and may tie their dinghies to the concrete bulkhead.
3. Transients are to promptly move to another vacant mooring when requested by the returning mooring holder.
4. No transient vessel shall stay in the Cove more **than 72 hours**, and must not return sooner than 7 days, except when granted permission by the Harbor Master or the Harbor Management Commission.
5. Vessels tied to the town dock shall not be left unattended and shall not remain longer than 20 minutes while another vessel is waiting to use the dock.
6. All refuse is to be placed in the waste receptacles at the head of the town dock. The penalty for discarding rubbish in any other manner is punishable by \$1,000 fine or imprisonment of three months or both.
7. No discharge of human waste is permitted anywhere in the Cove. Contact CT Department of Environmental Protection (DEP), pump out vessel on Channel **72** or **call mobile phone 860-463-9753**
8. Infraction of state boating laws 15-9(a) through 15-154(b) may carry significant fines.
9. No vessel in excess of 45 feet is permitted to moor or anchor in North Cove.
10. Transients are responsible for any damage they may cause to moored vessels and/or mooring gear
11. Transient vessels are required to have someone remain on board overnight.
12. Any infraction of these policies and procedures any mooring holders or persons on the waiting list may result in the removal of their name from the waiting list or mooring list.
13. The Old Saybrook Harbor Master and Town of Old Saybrook, or any of its agencies, assumes no responsibility for the safety of any vessel in North Cove and will not be liable for fire, theft or damage to such vessel, its equipment or any property in, on, or attached to said vessel.
